Sub: Proposal for establishment of a Degree
College at Dhaniakhali, Hooghly

With reference to your application No. nil dated 23.4.75 on the above subject, I am directed to inform you that the question of granting affiliation to the Proposed Sarat Centenary College at Dhaniakhali in the district of Hooghly was considered by the Burdwan University Council at its meeting held on 29.7.78 and the Council decided the affiliation be granted provisionally to the Sarat Centenary College for a period of one academic year only for the session 1978-79 in the following subjects and courses of study, subject to the fulfilment of the conditions stated hereunder:

Degree Course in Arts (Pass)

English, Bengali, Sanskrit, History, Philosophy, Economics, Political Science

Degree Course in Science (Pass)

Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics

This affiliation is subject to the provisions of the University Ordinances relating to the conferment of Degrees, Titles etc. subject to the provisions being made by the college of such requirement in respect of accommodation, equipment, teaching staff etc. down by the University from time to time.

Schedule of conditions

i) That a Principal with requisite qualifications as prescribed by the State Govt. and duly selected by the Selection Committee/Service Commission set up by the Govt. should be appointed from the beginning of the session 1978-79;

ii) that one whole-time teacher each in Pol.Sc., History, Sanskrit, Economics and Philosophy with requisite qualifications as prescribed by the State Govt. and duly selected by the Selection Committee/Service Commission set up by the Govt. and as per University Rules framed in this respect from time to time should be appointed from the beginning of the session 1978-79;

iii) that the existing teachers in English, Bengali, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics already appointed for the Higher Secondary Unit are to be appeared before the Selection Committee/Service Commission for final selection and appointment, if the college wants to utilise the services of those teachers in Degree Course;

iv) that another additional whole-time teacher each in English, Bengali, Pol.Science, History, Philosophy, Sanskrit, Economics, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics should be appointed from the session 1979-80 as per Govt. Rules noted under serial (ii) above;

v) that another additional whole-time teachers each in Physics and Chemistry should be appointed from the session 1980-81 as per Govt. rules noted under serial (ii) above;

vi) that one Laboratory Assistant each in Physics and Chemistry with prescribed qualifications should be appointed from the session 1978-79;

vii) that one trained Librarian should be appointed from the beginning of the session 1978-79;

viii) that to start with one Accountant and a Cashier, one Peon, one Durwan should be appointed in addition to the existing non-teaching staff already appointed for the Plus-two course;

ix) that tuition fees should be charged according to the Rules prevailing in the neighbouring Degree colleges;

x) that a Governing Body as per norms applicable to all other non-Govt. non-sponsored colleges under the University of Burdwan should be constituted within three months from the date of granting affiliation;

xi) that a Reserve fund of Rs.25,000/- should be always be maintained, and the interest accrued thereon should also be kept reserved in the said account; no portion of amount from this fund could be withdrawn without the prior approval of the University;

xii) that the scales of pay of the Principal and the teachers of the college should be determined as per Govt. rules and regulation

xiii) that books to the value of Rs.30,000/- should be purchased on all subjects of affiliation, of which at least books to the value of Rs.2,000/- should be purchased for each subject of study within the session 1978-79;

xiv) that addl. equipment and apparatuses worth Rs.5,000/- for Physics and Rs.5,000/- for Chemistry should be purchased forthwith. Analytical balance and Glass apparatus etc. for Chemistry laboratory should immediately be purchased;

xv) that the extension of the main college building with adequate accommodation should be completed within a year or two from the date of starting the college;
