Abstracts should be limited to 300 words and must include the title of the paper, name(s) of the author(s) and their affiliation(s), the complete postal and e-mail addresses and objectives of the study, methodology, findings, and conclusions/implications/recommendations. All the abstracts received will go through a blind review process and acceptance of it will be communicated to the corresponding author.
